The Advanced Technology Workshop (ATW) is owned and operated by Bridgestone Americas Tire Operations and is the company's last tie to tire production in Akron, Ohio. Located in the Firestone Tire and Rubber Company's Plant One building opened in 1910, a small team of dedicated teammates produces approximately 30,000 hand-crafted race tires annually in support of the Firestone brand's participation in the Verizon IndyCar Series. The ATW was founded in the early 1980s, and over the past 30 years has produced race tires under the Bridgestone and Firestone banners for a variety of racing series – INDYCAR, Champ Car, CART, IMSA, NHRA and various other forms of motorsports.
